SECRETARY'S REPORT: Motion to accept minutes by Jody Lounsbury, second by Bill LaPan.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Bill LaPan submitted a written report.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Continuing Education Bill passed Senate, stalled in Assembly. Free Membership proposed for newly licensed persons; usually associate members already: NYSAPLS trying to get newly licensed persons to try membership and stay on; looking for regional to be more active in keeping new licensees. Board discussed following up on OPD Cases; feel we need to be careful about revealing names. Surveyors met with Geologists; discussed what is being changed; still have issues with wording about "geological mapping". Benefits 2000 looking into 50% prescription coverage and 50% eyeglass coverage. and liability coverage for NYSAPLS and Regional Boards. NYSAPLS website is up; discussion on adding personal web links at small cost. If anyone knows of any wrong or missing information they should contact Meg. Four year program at Alfred to be reactivated. Board discussed survey work being done by State Police and what the work will be used for. Nassau- Suffolk will hold a summer function on August 4th. Mock-ups of improved Empire State Surveyor are at NYSAPLS Headquarters, including a new cover, better articles, interesting surveys, and articles by lifetime surveyors. In light of dues increase they are trying to keep the cost of improving Empire State Surveyor down.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT: An article was printed in Rhode Island State Surveyor about title company suing a surveyor from Hartford because he can't use scanner to make copies (see copy of article). It looks like Rhode Island continuing education bill will not become law.
