# EASTERN NEW YORK SOCIETY OF LAND SURVEYORS BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING April 11, 2024

President Meisler called the meeting to order at 5:44 p.m.

# Secretary's Report: Dwayne Cooper

- Dwayne reported that he had sent out the letter to the members on the proprietors list promoting the upcoming NSPS CST exam May 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Brie made a motion to reimburse Dwayne \$27.20 for postage, Kaleb seconded the motion. A vote was held, and the motion passed.
- Dwayne presented the March proposed meeting minutes. There was one minor comment and A motion to
  accept the March meeting minutes pending the revision was made by Tim Huggins, seconded by Ralph Hill. A

- Clarification was given that the leading zero in license numbers is not required on stamps, but the recommendations is to add it if a new one is being ordered.
- Concerns were raised about distance ownership, but were told at a meeting with SBELSG secretary Eric Greppo that it is acceptable if standards of practice are maintained.
- Roy Garfinkel reported that there was another meeting with DOT representatives, along with a GIS Clearinghouse Representative. There are many shared goals. Roy intends to focus on legislative efforts and funding.
- We were shown a clip of a TV spot taken at the conference which ran in Utica. Also got some press in a Buffalo Newspaper.
- Workforce Development committee has gathered 60 volunteers around the state willing to attend school career days, etc.
- There was an interesting discussion about the God Terminus.
- We were informed that Ulster County now has all deeds online.
